- ___1. The new 4-H Record Book is effective beginning this program year, 2006-2007.
- ___2. The new PDR has 8 categories instead of 26 categories on the old PDR.
- ___3. The new PDR can be used for Primary members.
- ___4. The new 4-H Record Book emphasizes life skills development.
- ___5. The new PDR format simplifies record keeping.
- ___6. 4-H members can use either the short form or long form PDR.
- ___7. 4-H age is as of the date the 4-H Record Book is submitted for competition.
- ___8. 80% attendance at club meeting and project meetings is required for any achievement rank.
- ___9. A 4-H member gets credit for one exhibit per event regardless of the number of projects exhibited.
- ___10. A 4-H member cannot get credit for the same exhibit more than one time.
- ___11. A 4-H member can get credit for both attending a 4-H event (complete event) and giving a presentation.
- ___12. A 4-H member can get a credit as both committee chairperson and committee member for the same committee.
- ___13. A 4-H member gets only one (1) credit for Junior/Teen Leader during the same year regardless of the number of projects led.
- ___14. Junior/Teen Leader is required for Gold and Platinum Star Rank.
- ___15. A 4-H member can get credit for Citizenship/Community Service outside of 4-H on category 5 on the PDR.
- ___16. A 4-H member gets credit for giving the same presentation more than once if it is presented to a different audience.
- ___17. A school officer cannot count on the PDR Leadership category.
- ___18. Only highest awards are listed in the Honors and Recognition category.
- ___19. Ribbons, seals and certificates are counted on the Annual Project Report.

- ___20. Participating in the school band cannot count on the new PDR.
- ___21. Sports team participation counts as one credit per year on the Lifestyle Activities category.
- ___22. Newspaper articles written by someone else about the 4-H member can be included in the Communication Skills category.
- ___23. A regular club or project meetings count as 4-H events.
- ___24. The new PDR form will be submitted for Sectional and State competition beginning in 2007.
- ___25. The State Project Competition forms will still be used in 2007.
